The video shows the real product and the alignment marks that the manual cant guite show. A couple of things I learned to make it easier to use, first the manual says to count the number of turns on the chuck. I discovered that it is easier to listen to the grinding wheel and when it makes very little noise on a full rotation, the bit is even on both cutting edges. Second, if you have some bits like mine you may have to align and sharpen 3 or 4 times to get the proper edge. This is not a fault of the machine, just sharpening bits on a bench grinder. I would recommend this to anyone who wants a quality bit sharpener that is easy to use and does a great job.Please try again later. Please try again later. The instructions are clear and direct, and the machine itself is very easy to use, just follow the instructions. I keep it handy, and sharpen bits as I use them rather than doing a bunch in one session. I didnt realize how dull many of my bits had become, but the vast majority were. I could definitely tell the difference after sharpening the first one, and it cut through some hard maple without any forcing. I use the 118 degree setting for my bits, but wanted to be able to have the 135 degree option for drilling in tool quality metal for making lathe tools.

I spent a lot of time this winter an indoor winter in Michigan this year sharpening all of my bits close to 400wood and metal. Some thoughts. 1. Yes,

Despite some other reviewers comments, the instruction manual is comprehensive, easy to understand and fully explains the operation of the Drill Doctor. I had no trouble setting up for 118 or 135 degree point angles. It took about 1 hour and 15 mins in total. After, they all were sharp, exactly to specification and cut through wood and steel like they were brand new. Ive always tried to hand grind my drills or bought new.

While they were fairly sharp and drilled OK after my hand grinding, they certainly looked handground and werent like a new drill bit with a welldefined chisel edge, relief angle, even cutting edges and a perfect point angle. With a couple minutes work in the Drill Doctor, I have perfect bits. Points to note The 135 deg point angle setting is the one notch to the right of the 12 oclock positioned 118 degree notch in the alignment port. The other 10 deg notches are to fine tune the chisel edge and relief angles, which 99 times out of a 100, you wont need to adjust. Make sure the spring steel jaws in the alignment port snap into the drill at its narrowest point across the width of the flutes. Rotate the drill bit as required to make this happen. This ensures the correct angular position of the bit in the chuck for grinding. After finger snugging the bit in the chuck in the alignment port, remove it and hand tighten. That way the drill doesnt move from its perfect alignment for grinding. Keep rotating the chuck in the grinding port with light pressure down and keeping the chuck against the cam pin, grinding until the grinding sounds stop occurring. The bit at that point is fully ground. Eventually the grinding wheel will wear down. After doing all my 34 drills, I could feel that the roughness of the grinding wheel was less that the other unused end, but it was still easily capable of grinding bits. Grinding dust does spill out onto the bench through the gaps around the transparent cover under the grinding wheel. After all my bits, I had a tiny heap on the table, with more inside the machine. I cleaned the Drill Doctor before putting it away, per the instructions. Dont mash the bit into wheel, especially for making the split point. Treat it gently and pulse it until the sound stops. Ive now got a way to have sharp drill whenever I need them. I always had to make do or go buy yet another drill bit.

The Drill Doctor is not a cheap tool, but it is wellmade and sturdy. Once you have it, you can really appreciate its value. No regrets at all. I will never need to buy bits again until Ive worm them down to an unusable length and by then, that will have paid back the cost of the Drill Doctor many times over!Please try again later. Bring them back to life with the Drill Doctor 750X Drill Bit Sharpener. Now before I end up sounding too much like a latenight infomercial, it's not all sunshine and rainbows. There's a learning curve involved and it's going to take some practice to get it right. SUPPORT OUR ADVERTISERS How to Use the Drill Doctor 750X Choose the Angle There's a knob on the right side that you can loosen. Insert Bit In the Chuck and Put the Chuck in the Alignment Port Loosen the chuck so that it will accept the bit, then tighten it down just to the point that you can still move it in and out. Press the lever on the back right the Alignment Button to open the jaws while you insert the chuck into position. Adjust the Bit Position With the Alignment Button still pressed and the chuck in place, push the bit forward until it hits the metal stop at the back the Drill Bit Stop and release the Alignment Button. Give the bit a spin until the clamps are holding it at its narrowest point. Tighten the Chuck, then Tighten Again Tighten the chuck up so the bit can't move without removing it so the adjustment doesn't change. Then pull the chuck out and give it a little extra tightening. Align the Sharpening Guide and Spin Turn the Drill Doctor on and align either of the white marks Sharpening Guides on the chuck with the silver Cam Guide on top of the sharpening port. Start spinning the chuck with light downward pressure. Pro Tip While the manual offers some guidance on how many turns it takes to sharpen the bit, keep going until you no longer hear it grinding so the Drill Doctor can completely finish the job.

Practice, Practice, Practice It seems like there are 100 ways to get your sharpening wrong. While it's not guite that many, you're likely to stumble across several as you hone your technique. The best advice I can give you is to grab some old, broken bits you don't really care about and just practice with them. Each time you do, you'll learn something new that will make working on your nice bits much easier and faster. The manual has a troubleshooting guide to help you understand what happens to give you less than ideal results. Drill Doctor 750X Advantages There are several advantages to the 750X model as you move up from the 350X through the various models. On the side, there's also a split port to give you the ability to create a split tip on your bit. If you're committed to sharpening your broken and dull bits to get more life out of them, it will pay over time. You'll realize your return on investment even sooner if you're using cobalt bits that are more expensive than black oxide and titanium. SUPPORT OUR ADVERTISERS Concerns After using the Drill Doctor 750X for several weeks, my only major concern at this point is the number of plastic parts that are critical for ensuring you get an accurate grind. There are a few more minor considerations as well. The angle markings are just etched in the plastic, so there's no contrast to help you see them. A little paint would be good, etched metal plating would be better. Keep in mind that you're grinding the tip of your drill bit, meaning a coating like black oxide or titanium is going to come off. It won't affect the entire bit, just the tip. Bits that have material blended with the steel, like cobalt, won't be affected like a coating. Finally, be sure to the keep the plug in your Split Port when you're not splitting the tip. This will help reduce the number of metal chips that come out. The Bottom Line There are a lot of plastic parts around the Drill Doctor 750X.

Similar to my feeling about the Work Sharp knife sharpener, I trust myself to take good enough care of it to last for quite a while. However, I don't trust the rest of the guys in the office ahem, David C. Smith to keep it functioning as long. The learning curve associated with it means it's going to be a better fit for woodworkers, carpenters, and general contractors that are going to tackle sharpening duties on their own or are willing to spend some time with the crewmember that will. Once you get the process dialed in, you'll save money on replacement bits. Just recognize that it's built more for sharpening in a controlled shop environment than a job site.
