Rain Master decoders are configured in 1, 2, and 4 station models, and as shipped from the factory, have no programming. In order to be recognized by the Eagle Plus controller, each station must be defined to facilitate decoder programming. See Figure 8. Note In this example, NONE indicates that decoder station slot 1 of 4 available slots has no programming. Turn the Dial to display the preferred number, then CURRENT ADDRESS NONE.
