Washing your filter will allow the soap to seep into the pores and this cannot be removed, making the filter unusable and unsafe for your pet. The filter removes bad tastes and odours to improve the taste of the water and catches hair and small particles to keep the water cleaner. Either wash it in the top rack of your dishwasher or handwash these parts. If your dishwasher runs too hot, we recommend handwashing. When handwashing, use a bottle brush, aquarium brush, soft sponge, or brushes included in the Fountain Cleaning Kit and dish soap. Please note if you have the Avalon or Pagoda fountains, the filter housing should be hand washed. It is not dishwasher safe. There may be a faceplate cover over the impeller than can be pulled up with a coin or fingernail. Wash the impeller in soapy water, removing hair and other gunk that has collected around it. A cotton swab or small toothbrush might work too, or anything that can reach all the way inside of the cavity. Fill with water. Replug in fountain. This is a new object added to their environment, so give your pet enough time to get used to the fountain at their own pace. This time frame will usually only take a few days, and it is very rare that a pet will refuse to use the product entirely. If your pet prefers to drink running water from the faucet or shower, your pet will probably get used to the fountain very quickly. This way your pet can get used to drinking from the fountain without the noise and splash of running water. Try setting it to a lower flow setting. Remove the filter from the fountain, then add tuna juice or bouillon to the water until your pet is used to the new product. After that, you can clean the fountain, replace the filter, and refill the fountain with regular water. They are safe to use with your pets drinking water. The organic charcoal used in the filters is made of coconut shells. The filters do not purify the

Change them every 24 weeks, depending on how many pets use the fountain, to keep the fountain water fresh and clean. If you have more pets or notice more debris, a slimy feel, or decreased water flow in your fountain, you should clean it more often. Prefilters can usually be changed less frequently. Over time, debris gets stuck in the outer fabric of the filter, making it more difficult for the water to pass through it. The inner part of the filter contains granulated carbon with hundreds or thousands of microscopic holes, which bind to impurities in the water that cause bad tastes and smells. This binding prevents impurities them from returning to the water. Eventually, the holes become clogged and can no longer remove impurities. Change the water and clean your fountain more frequently to prevent this. Soap residue may cause the sliminess. Be sure to rinse every part thoroughly before reassembling the fountain. To remove these deposits, clean the fountain parts with a 90% water, 10% vinegar solution. Rinse all parts thoroughly afterwards. Use filtered or purified water instead of hard tap water to prevent this. Some pets are prone to spilling. Watch your pet when he drinks to see if this is the cause. If it is, you can purchase a fountain mat or other waterresistant mat to place under the fountain. Look for visible cracks in the bowl. Some fountains hum a little louder than others. It should return to normal levels within a few minutes. If the noise

stops when plugged back in, its possible that some debris is caught on the impeller. Remove the pump and clean the impeller. Try rubbing a small amount of vegetable oil onto the magnetic pin with a cotton bud to lubricate the impeller. See below for full cleaning steps. Try adding plain white vinegar inside the pumps cavity without the impeller and allow it to soak for 1015 minutes. Clean all fountain parts in soap and water before reassembling the fountain. Gently but firmly press down on this pin to reseat it into its proper place in the motor. If the pin has completely dislodged itself from the motor, it cannot be placed back into the motor cavity properly and the motor will have to be replaced. Call Customer Care for information on replacing your motor. Sometimes it takes a few minutes for the motor to start pumping water once its refilled or plugged in. If water doesnt flow after 5 minutes, try these troubleshooting tips To prevent this, you can purchase a cord cover from most hardware stores. You could also try securing the cord to the floor with duct tape. Lack of regular cleaning may result in the pump becoming clogged with pet hair and food debris. The pump must be cleaned every 24 weeks to ensure proper function. There may be a faceplate cover over the impeller than can be pulled up with a coin or fingernail. Wash the impeller in soapy water, removing hair and other gunk that has collected around it. A small toothbrush might work too, or anything that can reach all the way inside the cavity. Hard water will cause calcium deposits to build up in the pumps cavity, blocking the impeller from spinning. If there is evidence of hard water buildup inside the pump, try adding plain white vinegar inside the pumps cavity without the impeller and allow it to soak for 1015 minutes. Clean all fountain parts in soap and water before reassembling the fountain. If your pet is prone to chewing, visit your local hardware store and purchase a conduit cover to protect the cord. If the pump has been in regular use for several years, it may be old and need to be replaced. The fountain parts and pump are not UL approved for outdoor use. Using the fountain outside can damage the pump. If you have used your fountain outside, the pump may need to be replaced. To prevent this, always keep your fountain water above the fill line.

You can also change the foam filter. This can cause the pump to overheat and stop functioning. When refilling the bowl, make sure to add water before turning the fountain on. Try switching to a top with one fewer spout opening. The charcoal filter is made of organic coconut shells. Rinse the filter in cold water before placing it in the fountain to prevent this. Some filters may shed more charcoal than others due to differing consistency of charcoal in each batch of filters, so dont be surprised if some filters leave behind more charcoal dust than others. After doing some snooping, I found that the water had been leaking out the bottom of the fountain all week and made its way through my kitchen tile had to rip it up and all the way through the floor to my downstairs ceiling ruined my ceiling, couch, and new wood floors. Highly, as an understatement, disappointed in this product. And of course, my return window is closed. Hopefully someone will be able to help me in customer service. It comes pretty much put together but make sure to identify the parts and pieces for when you want to completely clean it out. I love the cord and plug. The only draw back to this is that if you have the cord hidden from view and plugged in behind something, you have to take everything out. It would have been nice to be able to disconnect it from the bottom of the bowl. Its been about a week since I have had it running and its perfect. No excessive noise and the splashing can only be heard from when you are standing by it. My beagle mix loves to drink from the stream of water spilling down. It stimulates his mind also. I have had really good luck with this fountain. I must say that it was noisy for a bit, but I think it was because the water level was down to low and the pump was working hard to try and pump the water. After a few days, it guieted down again. I have well water. and it is HARD. I recommend that every few days, you take it apart its not hard or doesnt take a long time to do and clean it out completely.

I have a Weimaraner, Beagle Pit mix, Mini Dachshund and 3 cats who visit the water bowl a million times a day and when the dogs come in from being naughty outside digging holes, there is usually dirt at the bottom. You have to remember that this dirt gets pulled through the system and should be cleaned out. It had been more then a week since I had cleaned everything out so I took it apart today and it was completely covered with scale and hard water cleaned it out and used White Vinegar and Hot water and plugged in the pump and let it pump though for a few hours. OMG! It cleaned it so good. It looks brand new! anyone with hard water knows what Im talking about I should have taken before and after pics. I will next time. I think many of the issues people are having are due to just

No complaints on performance. I have cleaned it weekly takes about 5 minutes and replaced the filter weekly some say you could get away with every two weeks to a month, my waterweekly. Cleaning it has been a positive as it is only being done weekly instead of daily. The CONS of this water system 6 weeks of scrupulous care and cleaning, and the pump is shot. I will replace my pump and see what happens. If the pump is only going to last 6 weeks, that is a costly piece to replace approximately 8 times a year. If the new pump dies in a few weeks, this bowl will be turned into a standard water bowl and will be washed by hand every night again. This product is a great idea, but it needs to work longer than a few weeks.Please try again later. We are so sorry to hear that the pump has stopped, and we realize how frustrating that can be.

BUT I called PetSafe and they sent me a correct replacement so I standby the brand. Typically keeping at least 34 cups in it at all times keeps it guiet. As long as you do that, the noise is a soft humming that you get used to. We keep the fountain near the cat food and the cat has a bad habit of knocking food into it so this requires more cleaning than usual. But a typical cleaning is only needed about once a month unless you have super shedding pets that can clog up the filter guicker. Assembly So, the first one we got was SUPER hard to assemble but this was because we were sent mismatching parts. Once we got the replacement fountain it was a breeze and took all of 5 minutes. The cat LOVES to drink from the fountain spout and gets mad when it doesnt flow. The dogs were skeptical at first but they quickly learned how to use it. It does beat bringing a huge jug of water downstairs without worrying about falling though. But again, still love it! 1 Year Update My dog still loves this fountain, and so does my 4 cats. Sadly Im considering getting rid of the fountain now because of it being hard to clean. I have a small water fountain for my cats and its a lot easier to clean, mainly because of its size, and its easier to take apart. Also its probably just my dog, but I have to clean it very often and it just makes the cleaning more challenging. He cant dunk his whole mouth in the water like he normally does without the spout pouring water on his ears, which he is not a fan of. Both of our dogs GSD and Aussie were unbothered by the sound. I had seen some reviews where the dogs wouldnt go near it but I wonder if they maybe had a defective motor as the only sound from ours is just that of running water. Cleaning is a pain I bought the brushes for this fountain, but it's a constant struggle to keep it clean. There is no top over the dish portion so food, hair, and even flies eww get into the water. I'm constantly disassembling it to clean the pump, bowl and fountain area, but it's extremely hard to get clean. 2. Bad pump Fire Hazard!!! Less than two months after buying this item the pump melted literally melted. The manufacturer claims the pump will last for a long time so long as the bowl keeps filled with water and is cleaned. I've done both and yet it still failed. Also, there is no safety function that cuts the pump off when it fails so I'm fortunate it didn't start a fire and that I caught it in time.

The pump was literally scorching and melted the plastic casing so this is a major concern! 3. Poor quality filter I've honestly had better filter systems on the cheap 10 gallon aquariums than what this fountain has. I was hoping for a filter system that helped clean the water and remove impurities, but it doesn't filter out anything that gets into the dish so what's the use. I hope this review saves some of you the expense and headache I've had with this purchase. I'm still looking for a good fountain for multiple dogs, but have not found one yet.Please try again later. Those all broke within a few months but this one still works perfectly. When it eventually does need to be replaced I will be sticking with this one. It isnt however one of the quieter ones Ive used. At first, I thought that maybe it was a matter of adjusting to his new home but, it turned out it wasnt.

After a couple of weeks, I started to get worried because dehydration can lead to health problems and of course, expensive vet bills. Before I decided to purchase this water fountain, I needed to change the dogs water bowl twice daily because his drool would get in the water and, it ended up a bit smelly and slimy on a daily basis. I also noticed that as soon as he heard the shower running, we would sneak into the bathroom and drink water from the shower, garden hose, kitchen sink, etc. At this point I knew it had something to do with the slimy, stinky, stale water in his bowl so, I decided to give this water fountain a try. As soon as it was delivered, I put it together and turned it on for him and, he went right up to it to drink some water. I think the sound of the water running entices him to drink water. Now, he has fresh water for two days in a row and it doesnt get stinky and slimy as it used to get in the bowl we had for him. It is actually a nice sound, sort of like a babbling brook is what my girlfriend said. The dogs like to lap the water from the spout as it pours out. Keep in mind, depending where you place it and how much sun or light it receives, it will grow algae, like a fish tank would. Cleaning the motor and impeller are sort of a pain but I only have to do it once or twice a month. It also depends on how messy your pets are. For example, if you have dry kibble close to this fountain it will fall in and make the water gross.

If the filter housing is not physically damaged, this may be something you can resolve with a little adjustment to the assembly of the fountain. If the filter housing is not seated correctly, it is possible for the water to be directed to the inside of the tower instead of the top of the tower where it can flow down the spout properly. This can cause the water to come out of the area where the tower and basin connect.
