The organic charcoal used in the filters is made of coconut shells. If you have more pets or notice more debris, a slimy feel, or decreased water flow in your fountain, you should clean it more often. Prefilters can usually be changed less frequently. Over time, debris gets stuck in the outer fabric of the filter, making it more difficult for the water to pass through it. The inner part of the filter contains granulated carbon with hundreds or thousands of microscopic holes, which bind to impurities in the water that cause bad tastes and smells. This binding prevents impurities them from returning to the water. Eventually, the holes become clogged and can no longer remove impurities. Change the water and clean your fountain more frequently to prevent this. Soap residue may cause the sliminess. Be sure to rinse every part thoroughly before reassembling the fountain. To remove these deposits, clean the fountain parts with a 90% water, 10% vinegar solution. Rinse all parts thoroughly afterwards. Use filtered or purified water instead of hard tap water to prevent this. Some pets are prone to spilling. Watch your pet when he drinks to see if this is the cause. If it is, you can purchase a fountain mat or other waterresistant mat to place under the fountain. Look for visible cracks in the bowl. Some fountains hum a little louder than others. It should return to normal levels within a few minutes. If the noise stops when plugged back in, its possible that some debris is caught on the impeller. Remove the pump and clean the impeller. Try rubbing a small amount of vegetable oil onto the magnetic pin with a cotton bud to lubricate the impeller. See below for full cleaning

Allow the impeller to soak in a separate bowl of vinegar for the same duration of time. Gently but firmly press down on this pin to reseat it into its proper place in the motor. If the pin has completely dislodged itself from the motor, it cannot be placed back into the motor cavity properly and the motor will have to be replaced. If the pump has been in regular use for several years, it may be old and need to be replaced. The fountain parts and pump are not UL approved for outdoor use. Using the fountain outside can damage the pump. If you have used your fountain outside, the pump may need to be replaced. To prevent this, always keep your fountain water above the fill line. You can also change the foam filter. This can cause the pump to overheat and stop functioning.

When refilling the bowl, make sure to add water before turning the fountain on. Try switching to a top with one fewer spout opening. The charcoal filter is made of organic coconut shells. Rinse the filter in cold water before placing it in the fountain to prevent this. runs well although if I don't clean it every 34 days the pump stops flowing because it gets stopped up. Can't blame the product given the number of shredding animals using it. My main complaint is the filter compartment. The filter doesn't lock in place and because of the way you have to replace the top unit when cleaning, the filter often falls out. It usually takes several attempts to get everything to stay in place and set it up correctly so the pump works. I need to buy a second fountain but will not buy another of these. After having this fountain for a year it started to run a bit louder and one of my cats stopped using it. I was considering replacing the pump I thought the pump was getting weaker and that was why water was only going to the sides. Took me two weeks to figure out to clean the slit a bit more intensely. Now its running smoothly and is absolutely silent again!! I seriously love this fountain. My cats drink more and I know the water isnt stagnant haha. The filters are easily available at petsmart and petco. Its easy to clean if you take it all apart even the metal piece that the water pours onto. It does get slimy but anything will. There are tiny stains on the bottom of the bowl. Theyre not rust but just a pin sized little discoloration. Otherwise this hasnt rusted or gotten any other damage. At first, like other positive reviews have noted, found that our cats really liked it. Bought some filters and figured that with filter changes, it might need a guick weekly rinse or so. Also assumed that stainless steel bowl meant it would be easy to clean. Wrong on both counts. The filter sits below the water slide part, behind a plastic grate. Since there is no seal at any point, water is free to happily flow around the filter. Because the water is unfiltered, it collects and disperses hair and saliva through the entire flow of water. Additionally, the black plastic spout is formed of three pieces that snap together. To make that work, there are a great deal of channels, grooves and tabs that are very difficult to clean out completely, unless you have an old toothbrush, some powerful cleaner, and a spare hour or so. The pump, which actually was pretty stout, did have a hard time because of the gunk buildup and unfiltered hair. It also required cleaning presumably due to debris getting stuck in the impeller, resolved by whacking against the side of the sink and flushing with hot water.

The length of time between required cleanings shrank as the fountain is impossible to truly and thoroughly clean without dunking the whole thing a heavy duty disinfectant, starting as two weeks, then a onceaweek complete dissasembly and careful thorough cleaning of the slide, upper spout, lower spout, grate, pump, and bowl. It was a losing battle and I gave up when that wasnt really enough anymore. As insult to injury, taking apart the thing so often led to breaking one of the tabs that secured the large black plastic assembly to the bowl, which meant lining up the pump with the spout became tricky, requiring several attempts to get right. Removing the stainless steel water slide many, many times also led to the black plastic tab securing this part to partially break, which meant the slide became loose. But that was the least of the trouble, really. In the off chance that you have a kid and they have a project for science class where they need to demonstrate bacterial growth in a favorable environment, I would recommend this product. In all other cases, I would not. I think pet fountains are pretty great, actually, but you should look for a fountain that has a filter that works well and has as few plastic parts as possible. This is great if you love constantly cleaning up splashed water and scrubbing out furry muck. Oh, and then the pump will die after a month or so. Please try again later. This issue may be resolved by lubricating the pump. To do this, disassemble the pump like you would for your normal weekly cleanings, and thoroughly wash and dry all three parts. Next, place a drop of edible oil vegetable or olive on the motor pin. Finally, reassemble the pump, reassemble the fountain, and add water. You should then be good to go. Amy Ann 5.0 out of 5 stars I have been through all of the different Drinkwell Fountains the original, the platinum, and the multitiered one but this one is by far the best design out of all of them. The other Drinkwell Fountains always got really dirty and they were so hard to clean. The Platinum and Original Fountains always got water deposits on the inside of the bowl, and it was impossible to clean the reservoir and intake areas of the fountains. Mine eventually got so gross, I ended up throwing them out. I initially bought this fountain because it was one of the only stainless steel bowls, and while the fountain area itself is plastic, the bowl is so easy to clean. All the parts are detachable from the bowl, and all of the pieces of the fountain come apart.

I was a little hesitant that it did not have a water reservoir, but the bowl holds plenty of water, and because the bowl is open it is easy to add more water if I need to. The bowl is much larger than I would have thought. My 15lb minpin could probably curl up in a ball and fit inside it, but I would say the actual footprint of the bowl is about the same, if not a tad bigger than the platinum fountain. Filters I found out the hard way that this fountain will not fit the Drinkwell Platinum filters. You need to purchase the standard Drinkwell filters that have two sections. Overall, I have had this fountain for about 4 months and I wouldnt change a thing about it. Its quiet, easy to clean, and does its job. Go buy it now!Please try again later. Please try again later. Girl cat took to it within a second of plugging it in, and boy cat drank after about ten minutes of spying on it from across the room. I had issues with boy cat drinking from a bowl previously, he would dip his paw in and drink from his paw or he would splash the water out onto the floor and drink it from the floor. I didnt like this because he got the floor all wet, his water full of dirt and litter, and because it isnt sanitary for him. He now drinks right from the bowl. Ive even seen both cats drink right from the waterfall part. I think part of the problem previously was that they had a difficult time seeing the depth of the water in the bowl, and didnt want to get water on their faces, so to disturb the surface they would put a paw in. Now the water is moving and the surface is visible to them without needing to put dirty paws in. The charcoal filter is a complete gimmick and I will not be buying more. I say this because water does not need to

flow through the filter to reach the pump. The black part does not seal to the stainless bowl and water can flow under and around it, bypassing the filter.

This is not an issue for me because I drink our tap water with no filter, so the cats will be fine too. It holds a ton of water, with a min and max line on the black part. It is easy to take apart, the black part lifts off the stainless bowl with two tabs that hold it on. You can rinse the black part independently of the stainless bowl and then rinse the bowl and youre done cleaning. Really no other disassembly needed. The cord has a break in the middle where you can unplug it so you dont need to unplug the wall part. It looks sharp, and feels like a quality thing. There are rubber feet on the bottom of the stainless bowl. It is very quiet. In my apartment I cant hear it when the ac is running, and with the ac off it is barely audible from across the room. My parents have a larger dog model that is much louder. If the sound of this unit were to bother you then I would be willing to bet that any flowing bowl would bother you. I will update my review if anything goes wrong with it. Be sure to keep it close to the full level, itll help the pump last longer and give the quietest operation. Update as of one year later its still kicking. No rust or anything yet. Still pumps fine. It helps to have a sink with a higher powered spray nozzle to clean the slimyness that can otherwise build up inside the tubes of the pump part. I wanted to update again to say that I discovered more of it comes apart than I thought. Mine started flowing slow, so I started trying to take more apart. The black cover just above where the waterfall comes out is removable just by pulling up on it. This allows you to clean the slimy clear crap that builds up slowly in there. I should have been cleaning it every time and feel stupid now. The pump has a plastic screen on it and this actually pulls straight off. This pulls off too. I now just clean all these parts with dish soap and a dish brush and the pump works like new. I should have been doing this all along but I was unaware it came apart!
