The knowledge test will be comprised of 50 multiple choice questions sourced from the 2020 New Jersey Driver's Manual. A score of 80% or higher will be needed to pass and get your permit. Once you have passed your written exam and have your permit, you'll be required to display two decals on your vehicle one each on your front, and back license plates. During this time, you may only drive with a licensed driver age 21 or older in the car with you.

You should also be enrolled in a driving school. If after 6 months you are ready to move forward and you have reached the age of 17, you may apply for a probationary license. If you are 17 or older You must wait at least 6 months after receiving your permit before you may schedule a road test. Once you obtain your probationary license, you are required to have it for at least 1 year. During this time, you're under restricted but unsupervised driving. You must display a reflectionized decal on your front and back license plate. You aren't allowed to drive with more than one person in the car under 21 and you may not drive between the hours of 1101 p.m. and 500 a.m. I have a question thats not answered above. That is why you will be required to perform this task on your driving exam. You are more than welcome to wear contacts or eyeglasses if that is what you normally use to see with. In fact, you are encouraged to do so for the safety of everyone. Will I have to retake the written exam once again when taking my NJ driving test. NO, you are not required to take the written exam again once you take the driving test. How many other people can I have on a NJ driving test in the car with me. Although a licensed driver age 21 or older must accompany you for your exam, only you and the examiner will be allowed in the car during the driving exam. What if I fail my drivers test in New Jersey several times. If you just can't seem to get it right after your second attempt, you may be required to wait at least 6 months before trying again. Failing several times sends the signal that you are NOT ready to take on the responsibilities of the road and that you need MORE practice.
