If you dont receive a letter, make a note to renew your license at least 35 40 days before it expires. Persons without a SSN can now complete an SSN Affidavit in lieu of providing an SSN. If it is your first time applying for a license in Tennessee you will need to bring with you at least one item from the Primary Identification list.

New residents to Tennessee will also surrender their licenses from their former state. The second item may be from the Primary or Secondary identification list. If you are applying for a duplicate license or a renewal you just need to provide two items from either the primary list or the secondary list. If you wanted to change your name on your license you will need proof of the name change such as an original certified court order, marriage certificate, divorce decree, etc. Photo document much be issued by state or federal agency It also must be the copy that is registered after marriage and not just the license authorizing the union. A person who moves to Tennessee and has a valid drivers license from another state or country must apply for a Tennessee drivers license or TDL if they You will also need to surrender any outofstate licenses because Tennessee law does not allow a resident to hold more than one valid license or ID. If you have only a foreign drivers license i.e. issued by another country you do not have to surrender it to obtain a Tennessee drivers license. The TDL will expire when the visa status or visa program expires. The date on the most recently issued I94 document will be used to determine the visa status expiration date. However, for individuals in F1, F2 or M1 and M2 visa status, the course completion date on the I20 will be used to determine the visa status expiration date. For individuals in J1 or J2 visa status, the program completion date on the DS2019 will be used to determine the visa status expiration date. If, however, your outofstate license expired more than six months ago from the Tennessee license application date, then you must complete all of three drivers license tests. The outofstate license will be retained by TN Driver

Services and returned to the State where it was issued. It does not matter if the foreign drivers license is expired or unexpired; all three Tennessee test must be taken.

New residents from other countries will be allowed to keep the license issued by that country; it will not be retained by TN Driver Services when the TN drivers license is issued. Please review the Tennessee Drivers Manual for guidance on getting a state drivers license. These international visitors are permitted to drive in Tennessee but it is strongly recommended that an International Driving Permit IDP be obtained before coming to the USA. An IDP is not required but it is valuable for situations where traffic violations or auto accidents occur as the IDP will provide an official English translation of the foreign license. In addition, it can be used along with the foreign drivers license to obtain a Tennessee drivers license. The IDP, by itself, is not valid for driving in the USA; it is only an official translation of the foreign drivers license and must be accompanied by the actual valid, unexpired drivers license given to the foreign visitor by his or her home country. All IDPs used in the USA including Tennessee must be translated into English. In most countries the national automobile club or association is responsible for issuing the IDP. A list of IDP issuers, by country, can be found at, however international individuals should also follow the guidance provided by the drivers licensing agency in their home country. In the USA only two organizations have official permission to issue IDPs. Those two organizations are the American Automobile Association AAA or the National Automobile Club NAC. If you are hold a drivers license issued by any State in the USA and wish to obtain an IDP for travel abroad, please contact either the AAA at www.aaa.com or the NAC at www.nationalautoclub.com for online information and the application. The learner's permit lets you practice driving with an experienced adult driver. Driver and passenger must wear seat belts. Once you have practiced driving for at least 180 days with a parent or legal guardian, you are allowed to get an intermediate license. You'll also need to take a second vision test and provide proof that you completed 50 hours of practice driving time. Keep track of your practice driving. Once you do that, you can receive your intermediate license. Make sure a parent comes with you to sign the application form or get your parent's notarized signature on the form ahead of time. Tennessee does not allow teens with intermediate licenses to drive between 11 p.m. and 6 a.m. unless accompanied by a licensed driver at least age 21. You and all of your passengers must wear safety belts while you're driving and children age eight or younger and less than 4'9" must be in the appropriate child restraint system. The state does not place night or passenger limits on those with unrestricted licenses but you should follow AAA safety recommendations and the rules set by your parents. The license will still contain "Under 21" age indicators. Youth Program Parent Education Classes The list is endless. You can drive only when accompanied by a licensed driver over age 21 who is riding in the front seat. You can't drive between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.

You will hold a Learner Permit for 180 days before the next step. Drivers and passengers in the front seat must wear a safety belt as well as all passengers in the vehicle under the age of 18. The length of time you held a permit in your other state may be included in the 180day period, as long as you can provide a certified driving record from the other state. You must be 16 and pass the road skills test see below on where to go for that. You must have held a valid Learner Permit for a minimum of

180 days. You must have no tickets for driving offenses that add up to six points on your driving record during the immediate 180 days preceding your application. Your parent, legal guardian or licensed driving instructor must verify that you have 50 hours including 10 hours at night of driving experience. The SF1256 is a certification of driving experience. You must be 17. No additional tests are required, but you must meet these conditions You must have held the Intermediate Restricted License for one year; have no more than six points on your driving record; have not had a traffic accident that was your fault; and not have two safety belt violations. Basically, when you turn 18 or are a high school graduate or have a high school equivalency certificate, you automatically transition to the Regular Driver's License. The word "Intermediate" will be removed from the license when you obtain the Regular Driver's License. However, the license will still include the "Under 21" indicators. A Class D license is required to operate a passenger vehicle. For this license, you will need to If you show up more than five minutes after your scheduled time, you will not be allowed to test. Also, you'll need your own car in working order with the proper registration. In addition to presenting a positive proof of identity, applicants must submit a certified statement from a licensed medical doctor stating they are unable to operate a vehicle.
