Do I Need an Appointment If you are under eighteen years old, you must also have written approval from one or both of your parents. However, this will require you to take a mandatory driver's education course. To avoid the driver's education requirements, you must be at least 17 and a half years old. Examples of these appropriate documents include a U.S. birth certificate, a U.S. passport, an armed forces ID card, a naturalization certificate, or a permanent resident card. Other but less common documents include a marriage or domestic partnership certificate, adoption papers containing your legal name, change of name documents must have your name both before and after legal change, or dissolution of marriage documents. Your vision test can be taken with or without corrective lenses. Your behindthewheel driving test will require an appointment, and no exams are given after 430 pm to ensure that applicants have enough time to finish their tests. If you are under 17 and a half years old, you must provide proof that you have successfully completed or are currently enrolled in a driver's education course. Your driver's education course will provide you with a certificate

confirming your completion or enrollment in their program. For those over eighteen, you must be accompanied by a driver eighteen years or older with a valid California driver's license. You will not be permitted to drive alone with only a driver's permit. For minors, you will not be permitted to drive until your driver's education instructor validates your permit with a signature. You must always be accompanied by a parent, guardian, spouse, driving instructor, or adult aged 25 years or older.

For the driving section of your test, you will be required to locate and use your vehicle's controls correctly-including the parking brake, headlights, windshield wipers, emergency flashers, and defroster. It is up to the discretion of the test administrator to determine whether you pass or fail the driving portion of your permit test. If you fail all three attempts or do not complete the test within the twelve month limit you will be required to pay another application fee-granting you another three attempts in twelve months. Applicants preparing for the test should familiarize themselves with the information contained in the online brochure How to Prepare for Your Driving Test provided on the California DMV website. This will provide you with a checklist of preparations for the test. There are also several practice tests that applicants can access through the California DMV website as well. Even though driver's education courses are not mandatory for applicants aged 17 and a half or older, you should consider enrolling in one if you are particularly concerned about your success. As mentioned earlier, this fee is good for a twelve month period and up to three attempts at the test. Once these requirements are fulfilled you are eligible to receive a California learner's permit. You may obtain a full driver's permit any time after being issued a learner's permit as long as you can successfully pass the behindthewheel driver's test. If you are at least 18 years of age, you do not have to provide proof of driver education completion to obtain an Instruction Permit. To obtain a Minor's Provisional License, you must be at least 16 years old; provide proof of driver education completion; have held an Instruction Permit for at least 6 months; provide a parent's signature on your permit indicating completion of 50 hours of supervised driving 10 hours at night; and pass a driving test. If you are over 18 years of age, to obtain a Driver License you must pass a knowledge exam and receive a permit; and pass a driving test.New California residents have 10 days after establishing residency in the state to exchange an outofstate license for a California license. You will be required to pass a knowledge exam to exchange your outofstate license for a California license.

In California, to obtain a Motorcycle Permit you must be at least 15 and a half years of age and pass a knowledge test. To obtain a Motorcycle License, you must be at least 16 years of age; have

possessed a motorcycle permit for at least 6 months; provide proof of driver education training completion; and provide a completion certificate from a motorcycle rider training course. If you are 18 years of age or older, to obtain a Motorcycle License you must pass a knowledge test and provide a completion certificate from a motorcycle rider training course. If you are over 21 years of age, instead of presenting a completion certificate from a motorcycle rider training course, you may pass a motorcycle driving test to obtain a Motorcycle License. To obtain a Commercial Driver License CDL you must possess a CLP and pass the CDL road skills test. Teens can take the test if they are at least 16 years old, have successfully completed drivers education, and have held a driving permit for at least 6 months. The written test for renewal will only have 18 questions, of which you must correctly answer 15, and you will have 3 attempts to pass. However, if you hold a valid drivers license from another state then you will be allowed to waive the onroad driving test. Additionally, you will also be required to repass both tests if your drivers license has expired and you want to renew it. If you are under 18 years of age you must also have parental consent. If you are over 21 and have complete an approved motorcycle rider training course then you may present a certificate of successful completion in lieu of taking the onroad test. Pay the DMV application fee, this fee pays for both your permit and your drivers license. Pass a vision test if you wear glasses, bring them. Pass the DMVs written knowledge test. You have three chances to pass the test within a year. Remember, questions

for this test are taken from the California Driver Handbook. See the complete DMV under 18 checklist for current requirements. They will ask for these at the appointment window. If you dont have them, you wont get past the window. You will also need to pay the DMV fee and have your picture taken, and give a thumbprint. Once you pass your written test, you will be issued a provisional permit. A parent, guardian, spouse or adult 25 years of age or older, who has a valid California driver license, must be with you when you drive. He or she must sit in a position close enough to take control of the vehicle. It is illegal for you to drive alone at any time. If you did NOT pass the California Driving Permit test the written test at the DMV on your first try, please look at your application. You will see TWO different dates below your name. One says DATE ISSUED and the other says EXPIRATION DATE.

You have ONE YEAR to complete the process of getting your permit AND your license, and the clock starts ticking from the day you pay the fee and submit the application. If the 6month waiting period is beyond the EXPIRATION DATE, you will have to retake the written test, pay another fee, and get another permit. If you are already 16, you must still keep the permit for 6 months before you will be eligible for the driving test. Proof of insurance must be provided to the California DMV. The goal of a good driver is to disrupt traffic as little as possible. You should become highly skilled at identifying situations that require your attention, anticipating and predicting what other drivers might do, deciding on your response and then executing your decision. Make sure you have the knowledge and the ability to control your vehicle so a small error never turns into a dangerous situation. You should be able to control your vehicle in emergencies, in a variety of weather situations, as well as on varying road conditions including very slippery or icy surfaces.
