When another vehicle comes up behind you and sounds its horn or flashes its lights, you should Move to the right when safe and let it pass. NEVER speed up when another vehicle is passing you. Passing on the right is permitted only when it is safe and Driver of the other vehicle is making a left turn. You must never pass on the right by driving off the paved or main portion of the roadway. Passing not allowed when Approaching a curve or the top of a hill where you cannot see ahead for safe passing. An upside down Lshaped arm means stopping or slowly abruptly. Shift into reverse. While looking over your right shoulder, back up slowly while turning the wheel sharply to the right. When your front bumper passes the rear bumper of the forward car, turn the wheel sharply to the left. Keep backing up until parallel to the curb. Parallel park.
