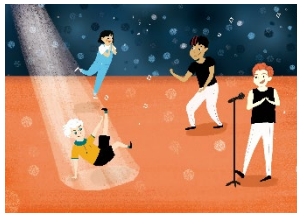

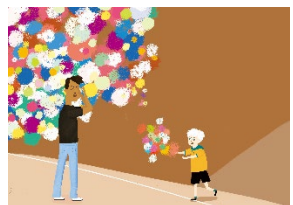
2. (Turn to pages 22-23.)

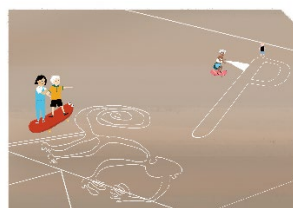
3. (Turn to pages 46-47)

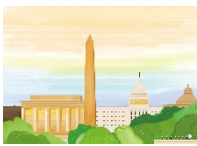

III. Read the story and answer the questions (10 %)

Skater flies to Osaka, Japan for Banjo to play sumo wrestling. He pushes the huge man across the room.

“Maybe I can try a more difficult sport.” Banjo says.

Skater takes Banjo to Bangkok, Thailand. He plays sepak takraw by himself against a whole team. Banjo asks, “Who can beat me?”

From behind him, Piper answers, “Maybe I can help.”

The two both move so fast and so strong. They play for three hours. No one wins. Then, Piper yells, “Watch out!” When Banjo turns to look, Piper serves the ball and wins the points. She beats Banjo.

Banjo doesn’t want to lose to Piper again. Skater takes him to the library of Congress in Washington, D. C., so he can read as much as he can.

Loo Loo thinks Banjo can learn about music, so they go to a concert by the famous K-Pop group, BST! Banjo jumps and spins, flips and flies. The crowd goes crazy!

Banjo wants to know what people love to do in big groups. He travels with Skater through time to the Holi Festival in India. Banjo sees Piper make a tornado of colors. She blows the color into the wind, and it all disappears. “Piper isn’t very nice,” Banjo says.

Banjo, Loo Loo and Skater follow Piper and Puno to Pero. They fly over Lake Titicaca and land in Cusco. When they go to the Nazca Lines, they see Piper and Punko making a big letter “P”!

“You are ruining this special place,” Banjo says.

Punko just laughs. As they fly away, Piper yells, “We will meet again!”
