"Not at all!" Loo Loo says. **Question 1. What is NOT true about people?**
- B** 2. "What do these festivals celebrate?" Banjo asks.
"We have festivals for everything! There are music festivals, food festivals, art festivals... Ha! I bet there is even a skateboard festival somewhere," Loo Loo explains.
"As there should be!" Skater says and smiles.
Question 2. What kind of festivals are NOT mentioned?
- C** 3. "In many countries in Eastern Asia, they have a Moon Festival, which is also called Mid-Autumn Festival. It is in the fall when the moon is full, big and beautiful. People get together and look at the moon and eat mooncakes. There is an old story that a lady named Chang-E lives on the moon!" Loo Loo explains.
Question 3. What is NOT true about the Moon Festival?
