第三部份：段落填空 20%

Pineapples, a yummy tropical fruit, are known for both its special taste and its effective health and medical benefits. 21 , pineapples also has its fashionable impact: Pineapple leaves can serve as a substitue for leather.

The idea 22 when a Spanish designer noticed a traditional shirt woven together with fibers of pineapple leaves in the Philippines. After researching for a long time, she created a material similar to real leather from pineapple leaves, which can be used in 23 textile products such as bags and shoes.

This pineapple-leave leather is 24 eco-friendly than real leather and synthetic leathers. It is safer for the workers in the factories because it 25 fewer chemicals. Moreover,the leftover material produced when removing fibers can even be a fertilizer in the pineapple fields.

This innovative material has been applied by many leading fashion companies to make their products because of its low cost.

Matter of Trust, a nonprofit organization, comes up with a creative solution for removing the large-scale oil spill in the Gulf of Mexico in 2010, using renewable 27: human hair, of which there is an unlimited supply.
